## **B.S. in AGRICULTURE**

### **Lower Division Core Program**

AGBUS 7 or 71; AGMEC 51 or 52; \*AGRI 20 or 60; \*\*ANSCI 20 or 61; \*\*\*CHEM 1A or 4A or 42; CHEM 8 or 1B or 4B; MATH 15

6 units selected from any lower division Agriculture, Agricultural Business, Agricultural Engineering Technology, Animal Science, or Plant Sciences courses in consultation with an adviser.

***Students must select one of the following options in addition to the core program:***

#### **Agriscience and Education Option**

***Agricultural Education Area of Study:*** Add AGRI 50

**Animal Science Option:** Take both \*\*ANSCI 20 and 61

***Pre-Professional: Food Animal Veterinary Medicine Area of Study:*** Add BIO 2.1; BIO 2.2+2.3 or MICRO 5; CHEM 12A.

Students selecting this area of study must select \*\*\*CHEM 1A+1B or 4A+4B from the lower division core. Additional lower division requirements for application to veterinary school include PHYS 2A/3A & 2B/3B.

**Crops, Horticulture, Land Resource Management Option:** Take both \*AGRI 20 and 60

### **Lower Division Major Course Requirements**

AGBUS 7 + 71; AGRI 20 or ANSCI 20; AGRI 60; CHEM 1A or 42; ECON 1A; MATH 15

6 units selected from any lower division Agriculture, Agricultural Business, Agricultural Engineering Technology, Animal Science, or Plant Sciences courses in consultation with an adviser.
