- Applications will only be accepted for the fall term and must be submitted during the initial filing period (Oct. 1 - Nov. 30). Per state impaction requirements, only California residents are eligible to apply.
- Upper division transfer applicants must complete 60 semester units of transferable coursework, including 30 units of GE, with grades of "C" or better by the end of the spring term for the next fall quarter; meet regular University admission requirements; and meet additional standards required by the Department of Architecture.
- The 30 units of GE must include the "Golden Four" courses with grades of "C" or better. The Golden Four courses consist of Oral Communication, English Composition, Critical Thinking and Quantitative Reasoning. These courses shall all have been completed by the end of the fall quarter in which the student applies.
- Transfer applicants will be ranked by college grade point average of transferable courses. A minimum GPA of 3.2 is required for admission.
- Transcripts must be on file in the Office of Admissions and Outreach ([Check for the deadline](#), which may change.)
- Students who are offered admission will submit portfolios for review and placement in design.

Required Support Courses: ENGL 1B or 5; MATH 58; PHYS 20/20L; SPCH 3A

Required Core Courses (subject to portfolio review): ARCH 12, 25A, 25B

CAL POLY, SAN LUIS OBISPO

The Bachelor of Architecture degree program is IMPACTED. Admission of transfer applicants is competitive. When reviewing applications, Cal Poly SLO considers the intended major, completion of CSU and Cal Poly program required coursework with grades of C or better, completion of CSU GE or IGETC, academic performance in classes (GPA), extra-curricular activities and work experience. **Important transfer selection criteria for this major can be found at www.ess.calpoly.edu/admiss/undergrad/transfer-models/archa.html.**
