**MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION**

- 1) Complete all prerequisite courses listed below with a letter grade of C- or higher no more than 5 years before starting the business major. If you repeated or have taken more than one course to fulfill a prerequisite, you must use the first attempt to satisfy the requirement. If you received a C- or higher for your first attempt, you should not repeat the prerequisite.
- 2) Complete the foreign language requirement.
- 3) Complete at least 60 UC-transferable semester units.

**Note:** All required courses **must** be completed by the end of the spring term prior to starting at the UCB Haas School of Business. IGETC does not satisfy these requirements.

**PREREQUISITE COURSES - must be completed for letter grades**

- One general business course = BAD 10
- Two semesters of calculus = MATH 1A, 1B or 8A, 8B
- Courses in Macro and Micro economics = ECON 1A and 1B
- Statistics = MATH 15
- English/Reading & Composition (R & C) = ENGL 1A+1B+5 (complete the entire sequence at one school)

**BREADTH REQUIREMENTS**

Breadth is not required for admission to the Haas Undergraduate Program. However, students are encouraged to spread breadth coursework over four years.

**Breadth Guidelines for Haas Applicants:**

- Requirements must be met with courses – no AP, IB (scores of A, B, or C on GCE A levels are accepted).
- Courses may be taken for a grade (C- or better), P/NP, or CR/NC (if P or CR means C- or better).
- Courses must carry a minimum of 2 semester or 3 quarter units.
- Haas applicants may not use business, prerequisite, macro- or micro-economics courses for breadth.
- Not more than 2 courses offered by the same department may be used.
- Courses used for breadth credit may not also be used to meet the Reading and Composition, Quantitative Reasoning, or Foreign Language requirements.

**Students applying to Haas must take one course from each of the following seven areas:**

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**FOREIGN LANGUAGE** – may be satisfied by receiving a grade of C- or higher in high school courses comparable to the third year level of any language other than the language of high school instruction. (For many students who attended high school outside of the U.S., where **English is not the language of instruction**, then English is their foreign language.)

– **or** – Pass a course comparable to the second semester of a foreign language as taught at UCB. SRJC courses that satisfy this requirement: **ASL 2, FREN 2, GERM 2, HEBREW 2, ITAL 2, SPAN 2**

**AMERICAN CULTURES GRADUATION REQUIREMENT**

Not an admission requirement. However, all students who graduate from Berkeley must satisfy the American Cultures requirement by passing one Berkeley American Cultures course or an approved community college course. American Cultures courses may be used to satisfy other requirements. SRJC courses that will satisfy this requirement: COMM 7, HIST 21, HUMAN 6, THAR 6
