CSU SACRAMENTO

B.A. in Child Development

Students working toward the B.A. degree may select one of five concentrations and complete the courses listed below:

Required Lower Division Courses: CHLD 10* or PSYCH 4; SOC 10; a general biology course such as BIO 10

* The Elementary Pre-Credential Subject Matter Program requires CHLD 10.

Students are required to select additional units of course work and it is suggested that students work with a faculty advisor to select these courses.
