Lower division requirements: ARCH/CONS 71A*+71B*; CONS 70A*; BAD 1*, 2; CHEM 1A or 42; ECON 1A, 1B; MATH 1A; PHYS 20*/20L*, 21/21L

* A minimum grade of "C" is required in these courses for the major.

 - High school chemistry (one year), mechanical drawing (one year), and trigonometry are also required. If not taken in high school, these courses must be completed in addition to those listed above.
 - Construction Management students earn a minor in Business Administration with their BSCM, and are required to declare their minor in the College of Business when they have completed their lower-division business courses or are enrolled in their final lower division business classes.
