### **CSU CHICO**

#### **BFA – Art – Electronic Arts Option**

Computer Animation Studio, Intermedia Studio, and Multimedia Studio patterns

Program Admission Prerequisites: ART 2.1, 2.2, 3 or 4, 5, 7A

Lower Division Option Core: ART 36

**Computer Animation Studio Pattern:** Add ART 31A; CS 10

**Intermedia Studio Pattern:** Add two courses of three units each selected from ART 14A, 24, 31A, 33A

**Multimedia Studio Pattern:** Add MEDIA 42, 78

**NOTE:** This major has modifications to General Education requirements. Please see the current CSU Chico catalog for details.

### **CSU DOMINGUEZ HILLS**

#### **BA - Digital Media Arts**

Options in Audio Recording, Music Technology, and Television Arts

**No lower division courses required for this major. The following are RECOMMENDED ELECTIVES by CSU DH:**

ART 3; ART 59; JOUR 2; MEDIA 4; A course in Music Fundamentals and/or Introduction to Music Theory

### **CSU EAST BAY**

#### **BA - Art**

Web Design Option (Electronic Art)

**Core requirements:** ART 7A or 7B or 12; CS 74.11; CS 50.21A+50.21B; and one 3-unit course from ART 5, 13, 14A, 14B, 14C, 24, 33A, 34B, 36, 37, 57, 60A, 62 or additional studio art course by advisement.

#### **BFA - Art**

Web Design Option (Electronic Art)

**Core requirements:** are the same as those listed above for the BA degree.

*To pursue studies leading to the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree, students must first be admitted to CSU East Bay as an art major (B.A.). Admission to the BFA is by portfolio review after completion of 30 units of studio art coursework. A grade point average of 3.5 or better is required for admission to and continuation in the program.*

### **SAN DIEGO STATE UNIVERSITY**

#### **BA - Applied Arts and Sciences**

**Art Major - Emphasis in Multimedia** is designated as an **impacted** major and specific criteria, which include a portion of the Preparation for the Major, are used to admit students. A cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher is required.

**For admission:** Complete the following courses with a letter grade of C or higher: ART 2.1+2.2+2.3, 3, 5, 7A, 7B

**Additional requirements:** 6 units of art electives

---

### **SAN JOSE STATE UNIVERSITY**

Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 required for admission consideration to all art concentrations.

#### **BFA - Art**

Digital Media Art Concentration

**Lower Division Requirements:** ART 2.1 or 2.2, 3, 5, 7A, 36

#### **BFA - Art**

Animation/Illustration Concentration

**Lower Division Requirements:** ART 2.1 or 2.2, 3, 4, 7A, 12; APTECH 53

**Note:** Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale in all art/design courses to earn a BFA; failing this, the BFA status will be changed to the BA-ART.

For both majors, ENGL 1B or 5 or PHIL 5 or SPCH 9 = prerequisite to upper division writing. SJSU also requires 2 units of PE in at least two different activities for graduation.

## **UCLA**

### **BA - Design/Media Arts, School of Arts and Architecture**

**Preparation for the major:** One course each in basic drawing, color theory, two-dimensional and three-dimensional form, digital media/computer design, programming for media arts, letterforms & typography, design history, design culture, and interactivity and media art. The department will determine exemptions from lower division requirements after admission.

A portfolio of 7 - 10 images of student's original work and a self-portrait in any medium is required. **The portfolio must be submitted in jpeg or pdf format.** Applicants with work in video, sound, or using interactive media may submit excerpts totaling no more than two minutes as .avi, .mov, .mp3 or .wav files. Applicants must also complete a departmental supplemental application (in addition to the general UC Application Personal Statement) and include a pdf of an unofficial transcript.

## **ACADEMY OF ART UNIVERSITY, San Francisco, California**

### **The Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) Degree**

BFA Degrees are offered in the School of Animation and Visual Effects, the School of Web Design & New Media, the School of Multimedia Communications, the School of Illustration, and others.

*A maximum of 30 semester units can be applied towards the Liberal Arts course requirements at the Academy of Art University. Nine semester units of transfer level art classes that are related to Academy of Art majors can also be transferred as art elective units. A maximum of 30 units may be transferred in combination of Liberal Arts and Art Elective transfer credit. Department directors may transfer additional units based on portfolio review. These units do not count towards the 30 unit maximum mentioned above. However, a maximum of 66 units may be transferred in total towards the BFA degree.*

#### **Liberal Arts Core to be taken by all BFA Majors (21 units):**

English Composition (9 units): ENGL 1A, ENGL 2, ENGL 1B

Art History (9 units): ART 2.1 and 6 units which must be taken in residence at AAU

U.S. History (3 units): HIST 17.2

#### **Liberal Arts Elective by Advisement (24 units\*):** Choose any 8 of these classes to complete the Liberal Arts

Requirement: ANTHRO 2; ASTRON 3; BMG 52; BMK 50; ENGL 4A; FREN 1; FREN 3; HIST 4.1; ITAL 1; ITAL 3; JOUR 1; MATH 10; MATH 25; PHIL 6; PHIL 8; PSYCH 1A; SOC 1; SPAN 1; SPAN 3; SPCH 1A

\* Please note: the Liberal Arts courses listed represent some of the most popular classes that students can transfer into AAU. Not all of these classes are a requirement for all programs of study.

**Art Electives (9 units):** There are 3 classes or 9 units of Art Electives that students must take to fulfill a Bachelor's degree graduation requirement. Art elective courses are studio classes where students receive direct hands on experience. Students choose Art Electives that are of interest to them. Some examples of Art elective courses are Introduction to Ceramics, Introduction to Photography, Introduction to Graphic Design, etc.

Interested students should consult the Academy of Art University catalog as well as an Admissions Representative at AAU for necessary curriculum requirements, as course requirements may change after printing of the catalog.
