CSU CHICO

All English majors require: ENGL 46.1

English Literature or English Studies Options: Add ENGL 30.1, 30.2, 46.2

English Education Option: Add ENGL 30.1, 30.2, 46.2; ENGL 4A or 4B or 4C; SPCH 1A; THAR 1

Select one of the following areas of study: Creative Writing, General Studies, Language & Literacy, Literature, Literary Editing & Publishing, or Theatre Arts.

Theatre Arts Pattern: Add THAR 10A and 20

CSU EAST BAY

Lower division major prerequisites: ENGL 1A and 5

Lower division major courses: ENGL 1B or 2 or 7; ENGL 3

Foreign language: One year of a college-level foreign language (with grades of C-/CR or better) or pass a translation test administered by the English Department after transfer to CSUEB.

Creative Writing Option: Add ENGL 4A or 4B or 4C

CSU SACRAMENTO

Lower division major preparation (9 units): *Select three from ENGL 30.1, 30.2, 46.1, 46.2*

English majors must achieve a grade of C- or better in all courses included in the major.

SAN JOSE STATE UNIVERSITY

Impacted major

Major requirements: ENGL 30.1, 30.2, 46.1, 46.2

Elective: ENGL 4A or 4B or 4C

Creative Writing concentration: does NOT require ENGL 46.1

English Preparation for Teaching (Single Subject): Select two courses from ENGL 4A, 4B, 4C

Foreign language for all English majors: Complete one year of any transferable college-level foreign language.

Note: ENGL 1B or 5 or PHIL 5 or SPCH 9 = prerequisite to upper division writing.
SJSU also requires 2 units of PE in at least two different activities for graduation.

SONOMA STATE UNIVERSITY

Lower division major preparation: Select one course from ENGL 30.1, 30.2, 46.1, 46.2

Creative Writing concentration: Add ENGL 4A

Secondary Teaching Preparation: Take ENGL 1B and one course from ENGL 30.1 or 30.2 **and** one course from 46.1 or 46.2

UC BERKELEY

Lower division requirements: ENGL 27 and 46.1; ENGLISH 45B & 45C at UCB*

* ENGLISH 45B and 45C, incorporating American and other Anglophone traditions into a survey of British literature, have in most cases, no exact counterparts elsewhere and must be completed at UCB. It is possible to have an English advisor assess a UC-transferable, non-articulated course for partial fulfillment of a required course. To do so, the advisor will ask to review not only student transcripts, but also course syllabi, reading lists, and written work. The student must present these once they arrive at UCB. Only five lower division courses will be accepted toward the major.

Students must complete either (1) Letters & Science Requirements in Reading & Composition, Foreign Language, and Quantitative Reasoning or (2) IGETC by the end of the spring term preceding fall enrollment at UCB.

UC DAVIS

Preparatory subject matter: ENGL 1A or 1B; ENGL 46.1 and 30.2 and either 30.1 or 46.2; ENGL 2 or 3

UCLA

Lower division major preparation: ENGL 1A, 1B, 46.1+46.2; 4th semester of one foreign language or 2nd semester of one foreign language and two additional courses in foreign language or foreign literature, including foreign literature in translation. Literature in translation courses includes: ENGL 33; HUMAN 8, 10.1, 10.2.

Note: Transfer students who have satisfied the UCLA College of Letters and Science foreign language requirement at the high school level through the IGETC program may satisfy the departmental foreign language requirement with five foreign literature in translation courses.

Admission to this major is highly selective. With the exception of the foreign language courses, all courses must be taken for a letter grade. For more information, visit www.english.ucla.edu.

UC SANTA BARBARA

Lower division major preparation: ENGL 1B, 27; One course from ENGL 7, 30.1, 30.2, 31, 33, 46.1, 46.2

Foreign Language Requirement: Complete either Option 1 or 2 below. Option 1 is strongly recommended.

Option 1: Completion of 4th semester or equivalent in any foreign language currently taught at UCSB. Other foreign languages may be considered by petition.

Option 2: Complete A and B below.

A. Semester 2 or equivalent of a foreign language as specified in Option 1 above;

B. Complete 3 upper-division foreign literature in translation courses at UCSB, selected in consultation with departmental advisor.

UC SANTA CRUZ

B.A. in Literature

Lower division preparation: ENGL 1B; One course from ENGL 2, 3, 7, 10, 27, 30.1, 30.2, 31, 33, 46.1, 46.2

Required proficiency in a second language: One year of college-level study in a non-English language or demonstrated reading ability at this level.
