## **CSU LOS ANGELES**

### **Bachelor of Science Degree in Fire Protection Administration and Technology Department of Technology**

The BS degree in Fire Protection Administration and Technology was designed to meet the needs of various fire services for educational experiences that provide both technical and administrative skills. The curriculum was developed through close consultation with representatives of all levels of the fire services from local groups to state committees and boards.

**Required Community College Preparation** - *In addition to the following Fire Science courses, CSU lower division GE requirements for transfer eligibility will need to be completed. A minimum of 15 semester units of community college courses in Fire Science is required, as follows (semester units shown):*

A maximum of 6 semester units of community college coursework may be used as lower division electives. Select from Fire 56, 61, 77

**A total of 15-21 semester units of community college courses may be included in the major program.**

**University Requirement:** ENGL 1B or 5 completed with grade of C or better.

## **CSU SACRAMENTO**

### **Bachelor of Science, Special Major: Fire Service Management**

This is a special major hosted by the College of Continuing Education, but its academic home is the College of Health and Human Services and Division of Criminal Justice. The program is delivered completely online by Sacramento State faculty.

Applicants must hold an Associate's degree in Fire Service or a Fire Service Technology Certificate from a community college; have a combined GPA of 2.5 or higher; have completed Written Communication (ENGL 1A) and be transfer-ready. Applicants will be automatically reviewed for admission criteria when the departmental application and college transcripts are submitted to the program.

To apply, print out and submit the Departmental Application along with copies of your college transcripts (unofficial are OK). If you decide to enroll in the program, you will be required to complete the CSU Application for Admission and submit official transcripts and application fees.
