### **CSU CHICO**

#### **B.A. in Communication Design - Graphic Design Option**

**Lower Division courses:** ART 2.1 or 2.2; ART 3 or 4; ART 7A; ART 36 or 59 or 82\*; GD 20, 51; MEDIA 4 or JOUR 1; MEDIA 78

*\* Must be completed for 3 units*

**Portfolio Requirement:** The successful completion of a portfolio based on work done in ART 3 or 4, ART 7A, ART 36 or 59 or 82, and CDES 230 at Chico (no articulated SRJC course) is necessary for entry into upper division Graphic Design coursework. Please consult the CSUC catalog.

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### **CSU EAST BAY**

#### **B.A. in Art - Graphic Design Option (Electronic Art)**

**Lower division courses:** ART 7A or 7B or 12; CS 74.11, 50.21A+50.21B

**B.F.A. in Art - Graphic Design Option:** The same lower division courses are required as for the B.A. degree. Students must first be admitted to CSU East Bay and declare an Art Major B.A. Admission to the B.F.A. is by portfolio review after completion of 30 units of studio art coursework. A 3.5 GPA or better is required for admission and continuation in the B.F.A. program.

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### **CSU LONG BEACH**

#### **B.F.A. in Art (Impacted Major) - Graphic Design Option**

**Required lower division courses:** ART 1.1 or 2.1; ART 1.2 or 2.2 or 2.3; ART 3, 4 or 14A, 5, 7A, 12; GD 20

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### **CSU SACRAMENTO**

#### **B.S. in Graphic Design – (Impacted Major)**

CSUS Graphic Design Program requires all students seeking access to the upper division courses to complete a formal supplemental application and to be admitted to the major. Applicants must submit a portfolio for a faculty-juried review. 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### **SAN DIEGO STATE UNIVERSITY**

#### **B.A. in Art - Emphasis in Graphic Design (Impacted Major)**

Students must earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and complete each the following courses with a letter grade of C or higher.

**Required Lower Division Courses:** ART 2.1+2.2+2.3, 3, 5, 7A, 7B

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### **SAN JOSE STATE UNIVERSITY**

#### **B.F.A. in Graphic Design (Impacted Major)**

Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA in all art/design courses; failing this, the BFA status will be changed to BA - Art.

**Required Lower Division Courses:** ART 2.1, 2.2; ART 3, 4, 5, 7A, 36; APGR 20

ENGL 1B or 5 or PHIL 5 or SPCH 9 = the prerequisite for upper division writing. SJSU also requires two units of PE including at least two different activities for graduation.

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### **CAL POLY SAN LUIS OBISPO**

#### **B.F.A. in Art & Design - Graphic Design Concentration (Impacted Major)**

Applications accepted only for the fall quarter. In addition to competing for admission through the regular admission process, qualified applicants must also submit a portfolio to the Art Department. *Note:* Students must complete full CSU General Education or IGETC Certification prior to transfer.

**Required Major Courses:** ART 1.1 or 2.1; ART 1.2 or 2.2; ART 3, 4, 5, 7A, 7B, 14A; Select 11 units from any Art courses not required in the major.
