#### **Lower Division Major Courses:**

7. Additional categories (e.g., statistics, gerontology, developmental disabilities) may be approved by the department.

#### **Child Development Track**

**Required preparation:** ENGL 1A (preferred) or 1B; CHLD 10 or PSYCH 4; MATH 15

**Lower division requirements:** BIO 10; CHLD 60, 60.2, 90.2, 90.4; PSYCH 1A;

**Optional:** Select either CHLD 68 or 90.1

#### **Lifespan Track**

**Required preparation:** ENGL 1A (preferred) or 1B; MATH 15

**Lower division requirements:** BIO 10; CHLD 90.2; PSYCH 1A

**Optional:** CHLD 60; Select either CHLD 68 or 90.1

#### **School Age Track lower division requirements:**

**Written Communication:** ENGL 1A (preferred) or 1B

**Oral Communication:** SPCH 1A or 60

**Critical Thinking:** One course from ENGL 5, PHIL 3, 4, 5, SPCH 3A, 9

### **Major prerequisites:**

- 60 units completed
  - 2.5 overall GPA
  - Completion of GE Areas A2 & A3 with C or better grades = ENGL 1A & one course from ENGL 5, PHIL 3 or 5, SPCH 3A or 9
  - Completion of GE Area B4 (statistics) with C or better grade = MATH 15
  - Completion of ANTHRO 1 or BIO 10  
(*Note: ANTHRO 1 meets a prerequisite to an upper division requirement in the major*)
  - Completion of one course from ANTHRO 2, PSYCH 1A or SOC 1
  - Completion of ENGL 25
  - CHLD 10 + 90.1 will be accepted in lieu of PSY 410 for content credit only, but will not meet upper division unit requirements for the major, for general education or for units in residence.

PHIL 3 or 5 (a second philosophy course is required but not articulated)

*\* UC Transfer Course Agreement states: HIST 17.1 and 18.1 combined – maximum credit, one course.  
HIST 17.2 and 18.2 combined – maximum credit, one course.*

Transfer students should complete courses comparable to the UCSD Human Development Program's screening courses before transferring (except HDP1, which must be taken at UCSD). Students must have attained a cumulative GPA of 2.75 in all transfer courses applicable to the Human Development Program, and each course must be completed with a letter grade of C or better.

### **Screening Courses:**

**HDP 1** - Intro to Human Development - To be taken at UCSD

**One statistics course** - MATH 15 or PSYCH 1B

**One formal skills course** – MATH 1A, 1B, 1C or PHIL 4 (*calculus is strongly recommended*)

**Two biological science courses** – ANTHRO 1; BIO 10; BIO 2.1+2.2+2.3\*; ENVS 12; PHYSIO 1

**Two social science courses** – ANTHRO 2; ANTHRO 3; PSYCH 1A; SOC 1

**One introductory computer programming course** – CS 10 or 17.11

*\* BIO 2.1+2.2+2.3 = three UCSD biology courses, but must be taken as a sequence to articulate.*
