The Bachelor Degree in Human Services is designed to equip students with the fundamental skills needed for a career providing a variety of direct and indirect services to all members of the community. The program provides both theory and practice in working with individuals and groups through program development, assessment, evaluation, counseling, and education. Typically knowledge of the skills used in interagency cooperation and computer technology, as well as the development of sound critical thinking and analytical skills are part of the program.

Related career fields include Community Services, Counseling, Gerontology, Health Education, Human Resources, Law Enforcement, Mediation, Nonprofit Administration, Parks and Recreation, Probation, Public Health, Social Work, and Youth Services. Students interested in related fields should check the College of Health and Human Services at the CSU campuses of Los Angeles, Sacramento, and San Diego.

Students planning to transfer to a California State University should **complete the lower division CSU GE and transfer requirements.**
