CSU CHICO

B.F.A. Fine Arts - Interior Design Option

Program Admission Prerequisites: ART 2.1, 2.2, 3 or 4, 5, 7A

Lower Division Studio Requirements: INDE 20

Note: The B.F.A. Interior Design major has modifications to GE requirements. Please consult the current Chico catalog for details.

CSU LONG BEACH

B.F.A. in Interior Design

Lower division requirements: *ART 1.1 or 2.1; *ART 1.2 or 2.2 or 2.3; *ART 3; *ART 5; INDE 63, 83

Impacted major. To be considered for upper division admission, applicants must complete the four requirements above marked with "*" plus four GE courses in written communication, oral communication, critical thinking, and math with a minimum 2.5 GPA and minimum grades of C in each course. Applicants must provide a portfolio of their creative work to the Dept. of Design. Contact the department for details of portfolio submission and review process. CSU SACRAMENTO

B.A. in Interior Design

Impacted major. Because of this designation, students must complete a supplemental application and a portfolio in order to be considered for acceptance into the upper-division Interior Design major. Applications are accepted fall semester only. The lower division Pre-Interior Design Major remains open for all students admitted to the university. Students interested in the major are strongly encouraged to speak with an Interior Design Advisor: (916) 278-3962.

Students wishing to become interior design majors must complete a series of required lower division courses with grades of C or better. See www.assist.org or www.al.csus.edu/design/.

Required articulated lower division preparation: ART 2.1 and/or 2.2; APTECH 45+46

SAN DIEGO STATE UNIVERSITY

B.A. in Art with emphasis in Interior Design

Impacted major. Requires a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher and completion of the following courses with a letter grade of C or higher: ART 2.1+2.2+2.3, 3, 5, 7A, 7B.

Additional articulated lower division course: INDE 52

Note: SDSU requires completion of lower division GE requirements for transfer.

SAN FRANCISCO STATE UNIVERSITY

B.S. Interior Design

Impacted major. Applicants are selected for fall only based on qualifying design project, completion of prerequisites, GPA, professional goals, writing skills (based on personal statement), and presentation. A Supplemental Program Application is required and available at <http://cfsd.sfsu.edu/> (click on Program Applications). From this link students may also find information on criteria for the design project portfolio.

Requirements for admission include completion of a minimum of 60 transferable semester units with an overall GPA of at least 2.50 and completion of the following prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C.

Lower division Prerequisites: ART 7A; INDE 20; INDE 50+67

Core Course: FASH 8

Lower division electives: ART 2.2; ART 36

Second year written composition (ENGL 1B or 5) with a grade of C or better is required to take ID 340, the beginning of the sequence of upper division SFSU ID courses.

The following SRJC courses have been articulated with upper division core major courses at SFSU:

INDE 52 = ID 343; INDE 62.1 = ID 342; INDE 63 = ID 540; INDE 64.1 = ID 445

Courses are approved as alike but not equivalent. Courses need not be repeated at SFSU, but upper division unit minimums of the major and degree still apply.

SAN JOSE STATE UNIVERSITY

B.F.A. in Interior Design

Preparation for the major: ART 2.1, 2.2, 4, 5, 7A

Support for the major: ENVS 12

Prerequisites to admission to the major: INDE 50, 67

Students must maintain a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale in all art/design courses; failing this, the B.F.A. status will be changed to the B.A. in Art.

ENGL 1B or 5 or PHIL 5 or SPCH 9 = prerequisite to upper division writing.

SJSU also requires 2 units of PE in at least two different activities for graduation.
