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### Liberal Studies Elementary Subject Matter Programs

CSU Monterey Bay publishes a major preparation format rather than a formal articulation agreement. The following information indicates which courses at SRJC are **RECOMMENDED** for entrance to the major but is **not based on a course-to-course agreement**.

#### Courses are listed by GE category and satisfy both GE and Major requirements:

**A1 Oral Communication:** Any Area A1 certified CSU GE course; public speaking is preferred (SPCH 1A or 60)

**A2 Written Communication:** Any Area A2 certified CSU GE course (ENGL 1A)

**A3 Critical Thinking:** Any Area A3 certified CSU GE course (ENGL 5; PHIL 3, 5; SPCH 3A, 9)

**B1 Physical Science:** Any Area B1 certified CSU GE course approved for Survey of Chemistry and Physics

**B1 Physical Science:** Any Area B1 certified CSU GE course approved for Survey of Earth Science

**B2 Life Science:** Any Area B2 certified CSU GE course approved for Introduction to Biology (BIO 10)

**B3 Lab:** Any Area B3 certified CSU GE approved lab course taken with the B1 or B2 course

**B4 Mathematical Concepts:** Math for Elementary Teachers

**C1 Arts:** A survey course of art, music, dance and theatre or multiple courses that cover all four areas

**C2 Humanities:** A qualified survey of literature course certified for CSU GE Area C2 with either a cultural or geographic scope; must cover multiple genres

**Additional Area C course:** A certified World History course (HIST 1.1)

**D6 History:** Any Area D6 certified CSU GE course approved for U.S. History (HIST 17.1, 17.2, 18.1, 18.2, 21)

**D8 Political Science, Government & Legal Institutions:** Any Area D8 certified CSU GE course approved for Government (POLS 1)

**Additional Area D course:** Any Area D certified CSU GE course in World Geography (GEOG 3)

**E Human Understanding and Development:** Certified course in Child and Adolescent Development (CHLD 10 if taken Fall 2005 or later)

#### Additional CSUMB graduation requirements:

**Liberal Studies Major Prerequisite:** Any course pertaining to Introduction to Education (EDUC 55)

**Second Language Competence:** CSUMB graduation requirements suggest that students transferring with 60 or more transferable semester units should have completed level 3 or higher in a second language (ASL 3; ITAL 3; FREN 3; LATIN 3; GERM 3; SPAN 3)

**Technology Proficiency:** No comparable courses

**Community Participation:** Students who transfer to CSUMB with GE Area D fully satisfied (9 semester units) are not required to fulfill Community Participation. All students must fulfill upper division service learning and possibly lower division service learning requirements within the major.
