The Liberal Studies Program meets the multiple subject matter program standards adopted by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC) after implementation of the federal No Child Left Behind Act. The Liberal Studies Major no longer provides students with a waiver for subject matter competence. Students will take the California Subject Examination for Teachers (CSET) to satisfy this credentialing requirement.

Students in the Liberal Studies Program do not follow the CSU General Education pattern; GE requirements are integrated into the program. ### LOWER DIVISION CORE PREPARATION:

**LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE:** ENGL 1A, ENGL 1B or 5, SPCH 60

**MATHEMATICS:** No comparable course – complete GE math for transfer. (*Students completing the Mathematics Concentration at CSUS may substitute Math 30, 31, and 35 which is comparable to MATH 1A, 1B & 5 at SRJC*)

**NATURAL SCIENCE:** BIO 10; no comparable earth science + lab course.

**SOCIAL SCIENCE AND HUMANITIES:** HIST 1.1, 17.1; POLS 1; ECON 1A\*

\*ECON 104 is upper division at CSUS. Students who complete an articulated course will receive lower-division credit only for the subject matter requirement

**VISUAL PERFORMING ARTS:** Upper division

**PHYSICAL EDUCATION:** No lower division requirements

**HUMAN DEVELOPMENT:** PSYCH 4

**FIELD EXPERIENCE:** No comparable courses

### CONCENTRATION:

In addition to completing the lower division portion of the core preparation outlined above, Liberal Studies majors must also complete one of fourteen concentrations. It is strongly recommended students select their concentration after transfer to CSUS in consultation with a Liberal Studies Advisor. See the CSUS catalog and Liberal Studies Advisor for additional information.

**NOTE: A minimum grade of "C-" is required in each course; a minimum 2.00 GPA is required in each area. To enter the California credential program a minimum GPA of 2.67 is required by the time you apply to a California teaching credential program.**

### CSUS GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

Completion of a course in each of the following areas is required before graduation from CSUS. These requirements may be met by completion of comparable courses at the community colleges.

- Foreign Language Requirement
- Writing Intensive
