### **B. A. in Liberal Studies**

The Liberal Studies major is an impacted program. To be admitted, students must meet the following criteria:

- Complete all courses listed in Preparation for the Major sections for the liberal studies major;
- Complete with a letter grade of C or higher courses meeting the requirements LANG 1 & LANG 3, MATH 1 & MATH 3, and DHP 1. *(These courses cannot be taken for credit/no credit);*
- Earn a passing score on the SDSU Liberal Studies Mathematics Proficiency Assessment;
- Complete a minimum of 60 transferable semester units;
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher.
