Parks & Natural Resource Management option: CS 5 or CS 60.11A+61.11A+63.11A; NRM 60

Environmental Interpretation/Education pattern: Add *four courses from* ART 3 or 4, 5, 36 or 59 or 82 (for 3 units); JOUR 2; MEDIA 78

Human Dimensions in Parks Management pattern: Add *three courses from* AGRI 60; AJ 21; AJ 22; ANTHRO 32 or 43

Outdoor Leadership pattern: No additional courses articulated; Upper division available at CSUC.

Parks & Facilities Management pattern: Add AGRI 20, 60

Resort & Lodging Management option: CS 5 or CS 60.11A+61.11A+63.11A; *Nine units from* BAD 1, 2, COMM 5, 6, FDNT 75, MEDIA 4 or JOUR 1, FREN 1-4, GERM 1-4, ITAL 1-4, SPAN 1-4
