METHOD OF INSTRUCTION CODES

The method of instruction indicates how classroom instruction is delivered. The California Community College Chancellor's Office has specified the following codes:

Code	Description
02	<p>lecture</p> <p>A session conducted under immediate supervision (line of sight) of the instructor of record using lecture, discussion, collaborative or experiential learning, that may also include incidental use of visual aids, various media, site visits, etc. at the instructor's discretion.</p>
03	<p>lecture/laboratory</p> <p>Santa Rosa Junior College Code</p>
04	<p>laboratory</p> <p>A session conducted under immediate supervision (line of sight) of the instructor of record in a laboratory, computer-laboratory, studio, shop, or other activity setting with students engaged in various scientific, technical, artistic, athletic, vocational, or other instructional activities.</p>
11	<p>tutoring</p> <p>Noncredit session where the course outline of record specifies that instruction is to be carried out by a tutor, as defined in Title 5, Section 58168 in accordance with the conditions specified in Section 58170.</p>
20	<p>work experience</p> <p>Session where students enroll for work experience credits as defined in Title 5, Section 55256.5 for learning that occurs at a job learning station as defined in Section 55257.</p>
40	<p>directed study (independent study)</p> <p>Session conducted with a student or group of students working with an instructor on a special topic or project, with hours of instructor contact, student responsibilities, number of units, and evaluation methods specified in a contract.</p>

Code	Description
50	distance education, delayed interaction Session under supervision of instructor not available by line of sight using medium where the content varies depending upon student response without the immediate involvement of the instructor (e.g. various types of instructional software, computer assisted instruction (CAI); digitized visual, audio or text selected in response to student input; or specially structured audio tapes, web enhanced television, etc.)
Distance Education, Simultaneous Interaction Session under supervision of instructor not available by line of sight using the Internet with immediate opportunity for exchange between participants.	
51	2-way interactive video & audio
52	1-way interactive video & 2-way interactive audio
53	2-way interactive audio
54	other simultaneous interactive media
Distance Education, Passive Medium Session under supervision of instructor not available by line of sight using one-way medium where the medium used precludes simultaneous interaction.	
61	text 1-way (example: newspaper); passive
62	audio 1-way (example: radio); passive
63	tv/video 1-way; passive
64	other passive distance education medium
71	internet-based, simultaneous interaction Session under supervision of instructor not available by line of sight using the Internet with immediate opportunity for exchange between participants.
72	internet-based, delayed interaction Session under supervision of instructor not available by line of sight using the Internet without the immediate involvement of the instructor.
90	field experience / field trip Session consisting primarily of field trip, excursion, or field observation.
98	other independent study
99	other / unspecified method of instruction
