PETALUMA PUENTE PROJECT

The Petaluma Puente Project is currently recruiting students for the 2009-2010 academic year. Puente is a transfer program with three main components: Counseling, English Writing, and Mentoring. Puente's mission is to increase the number of educationally under served students to transfer to four-year institutions and earn a degree. Students receive instruction in English 100 and Counseling 10 in fall semester, and English 1A and Counseling 80 in the spring semester. In fall, students will be matched with a mentor, who is a professional in the community.
