ANSCI 26, 26L	26 and 26L combined: maximum credit, 5 units
ANHLT 2; ANSCI 27, 28, 29, 30	Any or all of these courses combined: maximum credit, three courses
APTECH 45	Any or all of these courses combined with ART 5, 7AB: maximum credit 18 units
APTECH 46	Maximum credit, 4 units
ART 36, 36AB	36 and 36AB combined: maximum credit, 3 units
ASL 1	Corresponds to 2 years of high school study
ASTRON 4/4L, 5	Credit may be granted for either 4/4L or 5
ASTRON 12	Must have a prerequisite or corequisite of an Astronomy course to receive transfer credit
ATHL 16, 22L.1, 22L.2, 30	Any or all of these courses combined: maximum credit, 8 units
BIO 10	No credit for 10 if taken after 2.1 or 2.2
BIO 14	No credit for 14 if taken after 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 10 or 12
BIO 15, 31	15 and 31 combined: maximum credit, one course
CHEM 1A, 1B and 4A, 4B	1A, 1B and 4A, 4B combined: maximum credit, 10 units
CHEM 5	No credit for 5 if taken after 4A and 4B
CHEM 8, 12A	No credit for 8 if taken after 12A; 8 and 12A combined: maximum credit, one course
CHEM 10, 42	No credit for 10 or 42 if taken after 1A, 1B, 4A or 4B; 10 and 42 combined; maximum credit, one course
CHLD 10	10 combined with PSYCH 4: maximum credit, one course
COMM 10	10, MEDIA 4 or JOUR 1 combined: maximum credit, one course
COUN 10, 11	10 and 11 combined: maximum credit, one course
FRENCH 1	Corresponds to two years of high school study
GEOL 1L or 7	Must have a prerequisite or corequisite of a Geology course to receive transfer credit
GERM 1	Corresponds to two years of high school study
HEBREW 1	Corresponds to 2 years of high school study
HIST 17.1, 18.1	17.1 and 18.1 combined: maximum credit, one course
HIST 17.2, 18.2	17.2 and 18.2 combined: maximum credit, one course
HORT 8, 12	8 and 12 combined: maximum credit, one course
HUMAN 7	No credit for 7 if taken after 4.1 or 4.2
ITAL 1	Corresponds to two years of high school study
JOUR 1	1, COMM 10 or MEDIA 4 combined: maximum credit, one course
LATIN 1	Corresponds to two years of high school study
LIR 10, 30	10 and 30 combined: maximum credit, one course
MATH 1A, 8A	1A and 8A combined: maximum credit, one course
MATH 1B, 8B	1B and 8B combined: maximum credit, one course
MATH 16, 27	16 and 27 combined: maximum credit, one course
MATH 25, 27	25 and 27 combined: maximum credit, one course
MEDIA 4	4, COMM 10 or JOUR 1 combined: maximum credit, one course
PHYED 2, 3	Any or all of these courses combined: maximum credit, 8 units
PHYED 21, 22	Maximum credit, 3 units each
PHYS 1 or 10/10L	No credit for 1 or 10/10L if taken after 2A or 40 1 and 10/10L combined: maximum credit, one course
PHYS 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B and 40, 41, 42, 43	2AB, 3AB and 40, 41, 42, 43 combined: maximum credit, one series; Deduct credit for duplication of topics
PSYCH 4	4 and CHLD 10 combined: maximum credit, one course
PSYCH 34	34 and SOC 30 combined: maximum credit, one course
SOC 30	30 and PSYCH 34 combined: maximum credit, one course
SPAN 1	Corresponds to two years of high school study
SPAN 2, 2S	2 and 2S combined: maximum credit, one course
THAR 25, 25.1, 25.2, 25.3, 25.4, 25.5	Maximum of 12 units of transfer credit for any combination of courses or successful repeats with the following series: 25, 25.1, 25.2, 25.3, 25.4 or 25.5
WINE 2, 52.1	2 and 52.1 combined: maximum credit, one course
WINE 52, 52.2	52 and 52.2 combined: maximum credit, one course
