Variable Topics Courses: Students should not count credit earned for special topics (48) or independent studies (49) toward the 60 units required for admission. These courses will be evaluated by the UC campus after admission.

APTECH 46	Maximum credit, 4 units
ASL 1	Corresponds to 2 years of high school study
ASTRON 12	Must have a prerequisite or corequisite of an Astronomy course to receive transfer credit
ATHL 16, 22.1L, 22.2L, 30	Any or all of these courses combined: maximum credit, 8 units
BIO 10	No credit for BIO 10 if taken after BIO 2.1 or 2.2
CHEM 1A, 1B and 4A, 4B	CHEM 1A, 1B and 4A, 4B combined: maximum credit, 10 units
CHEM 5	No credit for CHEM 5 if taken after 4A and 4B
CHEM 8, 12A	No credit for CHEM 8 if taken after 12A; 8 and 12A combined: maximum credit, one course
CHEM 42	No credit for CHEM 42 if taken after 1A, 1B, 4A or 4B
CHLD 10	CHLD 10 and PSYCH 4 combined: maximum credit, one course
COMM 10	COMM 10, MEDIA 4 or JOUR 1 combined: maximum credit, one course
FREN 1	Corresponds to two years of high school study
GEOL 1L or 7	Must have a prerequisite or corequisite of a Geology course to receive transfer credit
GERM 1	Corresponds to two years of high school study
HEBREW 1	Corresponds to 2 years of high school study
HIST 17.1, 18.1	HIST 17.1 and 18.1 combined: maximum credit, one course
HIST 17.2, 18.2	HIST 17.2 and 18.2 combined: maximum credit, one course
HORT 8, 12	HORT 8 and 12 combined: maximum credit, one course
HUMAN 7	No credit for HUMAN 7 if taken after 4.1 or 4.2
ITAL 1	Corresponds to two years of high school study
JOUR 1	JOUR 1, COMM 10 or MEDIA 4 combined: maximum credit, one course
LIR 10, 30	LIR 10 and 30 combined: maximum credit, one course
MATH 1A, 8A	MATH 1A and 8A combined: maximum credit, one course
MATH 1B, 8B	MATH 1B and 8B combined: maximum credit, one course
MATH 25, 27	MATH 25 and 27 combined: maximum credit, one course
MEDIA 4	MEDIA 4, COMM 10 or JOUR 1 combined: maximum credit, one course
PHYED 2, 3	Any or all of these courses combined: maximum credit, 8 units
PHYED 21	Maximum credit, 3 units
PHYS 1 or 10/10L or 11	No credit for PHYS 1 or 10/10L or 11 if taken after 20 or 40 1 and 10/10L or 11 combined: maximum credit, one course
PHYS 20, 20L, 21, 21L & 40, 41, 42, 43	PHYS 20/20L, 21/21L and 40, 41, 42, 43 combined: maximum credit, one series; Deduct credit for duplication of topics
PSYCH 4	PSYCH 4 and CHLD 10 combined: maximum credit, one course
PSYCH 34	PSYCH 34 and SOC 30 combined: maximum credit, one course
SOC 30	SOC 30 and PSYCH 34 combined: maximum credit, one course
SPAN 1	Corresponds to two years of high school study
THAR 25, 25.1, 25.2, 25.3, 25.4, 25.5	Maximum of 12 units of transfer credit for any combination of courses or successful repeats with the following series: 25, 25.1, 25.2, 25.3, 25.4 or 25.5
