Currently, these two requirements must be completed by the end of the first semester of the program; however, completion will be required before the start of the program beginning with Fall 2013 admission.

Communication and Analytical Thinking (3 units)

Select one course from Associate Degree Area B

Select one course from Associate Degree GE Area D3

Note: Some, but not all, of the Speech or Communication courses listed on page one will fulfill this GE area.

Social and Behavioral Sciences (3 units)

Recommend PSYCH 1A or 7 or 4 (see page one) **or**
Select one course from Associate Degree Area D

PSYC 120 or 175 or CFS 120 (see page one) **or**
Select one course from Associate Degree GE Area B

Humanities (3 units)

Select one course from Associate Degree Area E

American Institutions (3 units)

American Cultures/Ethnic Studies (3 units) (may NOT double-count units in Areas A - F or Area I)

Global Perspectives and Environmental Literacy (3 units)

Select one course from SRJC Associate Degree Area H (*Course may double-count in any other GE area*)

Information Literacy (1 unit)

Select a course from SRJC Associate Degree Area I or comparable course

Math Competency: 3 units with a C or better (or P) from math courses listed under Communication and Analytical Thinking (*Intermediate Algebra or higher level*) or passing score on the Intermediate Algebra Competency Exam (ACE).

The Nursing Dept recommends that students meet the math competency requirement prior to entering the program.

Students enrolled at SRJC prior to Fall 2009 should consult with a counselor for other possible options to demonstrate math competency.
