All courses taken in conjunction with this program must be completed with a letter grade of "C" or better.

***The science courses listed above must be completed with a combined grade point average of 3.0 within the past five years prior to the end of the fall semester of the application period.**

A minimum overall grade point average of 2.5 is required for the above six non-science courses combined.

ASSOCIATE DEGREE GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:

Many of the courses listed above will also meet General Education Requirements. GE requirements must be completed prior to graduation, but it is highly recommended that the following courses be completed prior to entry into the Dental Hygiene Program. Graduation may be delayed if GE requirements are not completed before the start of the program. PLEASE NOTE: A course may be used only once to fulfill requirements in Areas A - G and Area I.
