GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR BACHELOR OF ARTS, BACHELOR OF SCIENCE, OR BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS DEGREES

(For the BFA, students must satisfy the general requirements for either the BA or BS. Consult the University General Bulletin for Bachelor of Architecture, Music, or Education degrees.)

BASIC COURSES

English Composition: *Two courses* - ENGL 1A and 1B

Multicultural Requirement: *Two courses selected from two of the following three areas*

- (A) **American Cultures** - ANTHRO 32, 34, 43; ENGL 31, 32, 33; HIST 21, 30; HUMAN 6; MUS 9
- (B) **Identity, Pluralism & Tolerance** - ANTHRO 21; ENGL 15, 22; HIST 18.1, 18.2; PSYCH 34, 40; SOC 30
- (C) **International Cultures** - ANTHRO 2, 30, 31; ECON 30; HIST 1.1, 1.2, 8.1, 8.2, 33; SPAN 39.1, 39.2

PROFICIENCY IN A FOREIGN LANGUAGE FOR THE BACHELOR OF ARTS

Completion of two years of college-level foreign language (taught in the language) with a grade of "C-" or "P" or higher. (Note: courses may not also be used to fulfill the arts and letters group requirement.)

PROFICIENCY IN MATHEMATICS FOR THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE

Completion of one-year of college-level mathematics (Note: courses may not also be used to fulfill the science group requirement.):

One **or more**: MATH 1A, 1B, 2A, 2B, 4, 8A, 8B

Two **or more**: MATH 9, 10, 15, 16, 27
