Math Competency: 3 units with a C or better (or P) from math courses listed under Communication and Analytical Thinking (**Intermediate Algebra or higher level**) or passing score on the Intermediate Algebra Competency Exam (ACE).

The Nursing Dept recommends that students meet the math competency requirement prior to entering the program.

Students enrolled at SRJC prior to Fall 2009 should consult with a counselor for other possible options to demonstrate math competency.
