

Pre-Chiropractic Program:	Santa Rosa Junior College and Western States Chiropractic College

Students must complete at least three years of pre-chiropractic credits (90 semester credits) with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. It is recommended that at least 30 of the 90 semester credits be completed at a four-year institution. Grades in the sciences must be at least a C average. Biology and organic chemistry courses should be completed within five years of entry. Candidates should contact the Western States admissions staff to review individual questions about course selection and overall background.

**Notes:**

- #1 Students generally earn more than the number of minimum credits indicated. They need to complete the entire year sequence outlined here.
- #2 Biochemistry courses will also meet this requirement.
- #3 Students may substitute MATH 15 for part of the physics requirement. Other courses that may be substituted include exercise physiology, biomechanics, or related kinesiology.
- #4 Applicants must meet the distribution of credits as noted. Many courses from Areas C, D, and F of the CSU General Education Pattern will meet the Humanities and Social Science requirement. Course credits from these three areas must total 24 semester credits. Consult WSCC admissions staff for applicability of specific courses (especially courses in the Music, Art, and Theater Arts Departments). *Candidates who plan to complete their bachelor's degree through the WSCC program in Human Biology are encouraged to consult with the WSCC admissions staff or the Bachelor's degree program advisor in order to select appropriate humanities and social science electives.*
