Films must be submitted on DVD
Foreign language films must be subtitled in English
Films must have been produced within the past two years.
Films must be 15 minutes or less.
The submitting filmmaker must be a full or part-time student at any school in Sonoma County.
Filmmakers may submit a maximum of two film entries.
Filmmakers must be able to attend the Friday, December 5 screening at the Petaluma Campus.
Each entry must include a completed entry form, film synopsis, cast/crew list and 1-3 digital stills.

Notifications

Films are scheduled at the discretion of the Associated Students Programs (ASP). The ASP retains the right to make changes to the published schedule at any time and for any reason.

If your film is selected to be included in the festival, you will be notified by Monday, November 24, 2008.
