



Wilson Craig to Receive 2008 President's Medallion

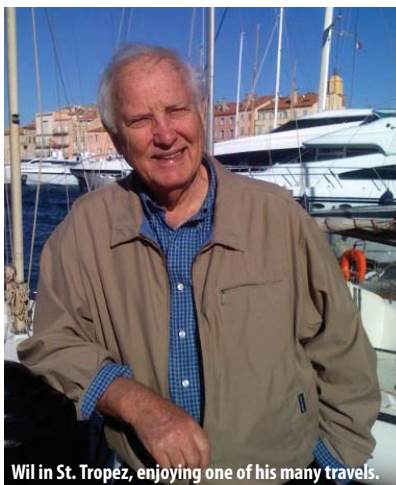

A 1956 alumnus of SRJC, Wil is multi-lingual, well-traveled, and is a retired SRJC faculty member who still teaches French at the college.

Wil is an inspirational example of how one person can positively promote and cultivate the growth of many. Over the last few decades he has established four scholarship endowments - *Ruth Parlé Craig Foreign Language Scholarship*, *Ruth Parlé Craig Study Abroad Scholarship*, *E. Juli Craig*

Memorial Business Office Technology Scholarship, and *Ruth Craig Human Services Scholarship* (multi-year). Countless SRJC students have benefited from these generous awards.

establish the first Paramedic Scholarship at Santa Rosa Junior College.

Under the leadership of Friends Chair Kerry Mahoney Davison and Campaign Chair Dave Martinelli, the Friends developed a Build a Future – Fulfill a Dream campaign with an initial goal of \$1,000,000 to support the future needs of the Petaluma Campus.
