



## **Golf Ball Drop to Raise Funds for SRJC Athletics Programs**

On Sunday, May 3 at 2:00 p.m. a maximum of 500 golf balls onto a mock green to benefit athletic programs at Santa Rosa Junior College. The drop will be held on SRJC's Bailey Field on the Santa Rosa campus during the college's annual open house to the community, Day Under the Oaks.

Golf balls are \$100 each and proceeds benefit SRJC Athletics, PE, and Dance programs. The four golf balls closes to the pin, win. Based on the sale of 500 golf balls, the Grand Prize is \$10,000, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place is \$5,000, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place is \$3,000 and 4<sup>th</sup> Place is \$2,000\*.

The number on each golf ball will correspond to a number that matches each participant and is registered with the Bear Cub Athletic Trust, Golf Ball Chairperson.

This is a unique opportunity for the public and SRJC employees to support SRJC's Athletic teams, as well as our Sports Medicine and Dance programs. Please note, registration closes on May 1, so don't delay!

*\*If less than 500 balls are sold, prize money will be based on equivalent percentages of total sales. Prizes determined by the four balls closest to the pin. See Rule #5 below.*



### **Bear Cub Athletic Trust Golf Ball Drop Rules**

1. A maximum of 500 consecutively numbered golf balls will be dropped from a height of 40 feet at the Day Under the Oaks event on Sunday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>, at 2pm.
2. The four numbered golf balls closest to the temporary golf pin will win. The closest ball will win the grand prize. Second place would be the second closest. Third place would be the third closest. Fourth place would be the fourth closest to the pin. In case of a tie, the purse would be combined and split equally.
3. Official golf ball number assignments will be posted on the BCAT Golf Ball Drop Web site located at: [http://www.santarosa.edu/for\\_students/athletics/bear-cub-trust](http://www.santarosa.edu/for_students/athletics/bear-cub-trust), at midnight, Saturday, May 2. No balls will be sold past this deadline and all ball number assignments will be final.
4. The golf ball drop and closest-to-the-pin winners will be determined by BCAT Golf Drop Chairperson and witnessed by a notary public.
5. The prize money will be awarded based on the following percentages: Grand Prize = 20%, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place = 10%, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place = 6%, and 4<sup>th</sup> Place = 4% of gross ball sales, with a maximum pay-out of \$10,000 (Grand Prize), \$5,000 (2<sup>nd</sup> Place), \$3,000 (3<sup>rd</sup> Place), and \$2,000 (4<sup>th</sup> Place). Prizes determined based on total number of golf balls sold.
6. You need not be present to win.
7. You must be 18 years or older to participate.
8. All federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of individual winners. Winners may be required to sign an IRS form 1099 or the equivalent for all prizes valued at over \$600 or greater.
