

UC Davis Fall 2012 TAG Selective Major Criteria

COLLEGE OF BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES– requires overall transferable GPA 3.20 (Biochemistry and Molecular Biology; Biological Sciences; Cell Biology; Evolution, Ecology and Biodiversity; Exercise Biology; Genetics; Microbiology; Neurobiology, Physiology and Behavior; and Plant Biology).

Complete the following courses by the end of Spring 2012:

a. Students must have a GPA of at least 2.50 for this group of courses, with no grade less than “C”.

b. Students must have a GPA of at least 2.50 for this group of courses, with no grade less than “C”.

Chemistry 2B	Chem 1A <u>AND</u> Chem 1B <u>OR</u> Chem 4A <u>AND</u> Chem 4B

c.

- A minimum of one course comparable to a UC Davis Biological Science course, must be completed with a “B” grade (3.0) or higher for admission.
- If students complete two or three Biological Science courses, a group GPA of 2.50 or better is required. Courses must be taken for a letter grade with no grade less than “C”.

Students are strongly encouraged to complete the entire Biological Sciences series before transfer. They may wish to consider completing the series during summer session at their current school or at UC Davis before enrolling for the fall term. This will allow for a smoother transition

and significantly reduces time to degree. Students who transfer without completing the entire series must see a UC Davis advisor before continuing with Biological Sciences.

- d. It is strongly recommended that students complete the following courses with a GPA of at least 2.50 for the group. Completion of these courses will help the student move more efficiently toward graduation. Courses must be taken for a letter grade, with no grade less than “C”.

Students must meet or exceed minimum group GPAs for courses completed in selective majors from the time their TAGs are submitted up to the time of enrollment.
