

**UC Davis Fall 2012
TAG Selective Major Criteria**

**College of Engineering – all majors require a minimum overall transferable
GPA of 3.30**

1. TAGS for Engineering are available for Fall quarter only.
2. The College of Engineering continues to require that each student must complete all the lower-division requirements with no grade below a 'C' for the specific major by the end of spring term prior to fall enrollment at UC Davis. See www.assist.org for transfer in specific majors – Engineering-UC Davis that shows the courses required for each Engineering major. Do not submit an Engineering TAG unless a student will complete all required courses before enrolling at UC Davis, unless the course is not offered at the CCC.

Note: All engineering majors except Chemical, Biochemical, and Chemical Engineering/Materials Science and Engineering now require Speech 1A or Communications 6* for transfer admission (with or without a TAG). *Biomedical and Computer Science Engineering will only accept Speech 1A.

3. Students must have a minimum 3.30 cumulative GPA at the time TAGs are written and must maintain that GPA throughout the remainder of their transfer work:
4. The following majors are available:
 - Aerospace Science and Engineering (formerly Aeronautical Science and Engineering)
 - Biochemical Engineering
 - Biological Systems Engineering
 - Biomedical Engineering
 - Chemical Engineering
 - Chemical Engineering/Materials Science and Engineering
 - Civil Engineering
 - Computer Engineering
 - Computer Science and Engineering
 - Electrical Engineering
 - Electronic Materials Engineering
 - Materials Science and Engineering
 - Mechanical Engineering
 - Mechanical Engineering/Materials Science and Engineering
 - Optical Science and Engineering
5. Computational Applied Science is not available for TAGs.
