

**UC Davis Fall 2012
TAG Selective Major Criteria**

PSYCHOLOGY in the College of Letters & Science– requires overall transferable GPA 3.20

Students must complete the following courses by the end of spring 2012 with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.90 for the group of courses. All courses must be taken for a letter grade with no grade less than “C”. Students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.90 for the group of courses that have been completed when the TAG is written and maintain that minimum GPA throughout the remainder of their transfer work in the required group of courses.

Note: Applicants for Psychology apply to the major, without reference to A.B. or B.S.degrees or emphases, which are chosen after enrollment at UC Davis. Transfer students are advised that although requirements for admission (listed above) in the Psychology major are the same for the A.B. and B.S. degree options, lower-division preparation for graduation in the major may vary based on the degree and emphasis. Students are encouraged to view coursework for the A.B. degree and the B.S. degree with emphases available in Biology and Mathematics.
