

**UC Davis Fall 2012
TAG Selective Major Criteria**

VITICULTURE AND ENOLOGY– requires overall transferable GPA 3.20

Students must complete the following courses with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00 for this group of courses by the end of spring 2012. Courses must be taken for a letter grade with no grade less than “C”. Students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00 for the group of courses that have been completed when the TAG is written and maintain that GPA throughout the remainder of their transfer work in the required group of courses.
