The Board of Trustees of the Sonoma County Junior College District is the governing board of the District. It derives its powers from and exists under the Constitution and acts of the Legislature of the State of California, and the procedures of the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges.

The legal description of the territory comprising the Sonoma County Junior College District, including maps, is on file in the office of the County Superintendent of Schools. The Board members, as elected representatives of the District, establish according to statute their organizational and operational procedures.

The Board has the power and responsibility to discharge any duty imposed by law upon it or upon the District, and may execute any powers delegated by law to it or to the District.

The Board shall concern itself primarily with broad questions of policy, rather than with administrative details. The application of policies is an administrative task to be performed by the Superintendent/President and staff, who shall be held responsible for the effective administration and supervision of the District's programs.

The Board shall act as a committee of the whole in final consideration of all matters.
