DUTIES OF THE BOARD OFFICERS

The President of the Board shall preside at all meetings of the Board, maintain order, enforce the rules of the Board at all meetings, and appoint all standing committees, temporary committees, and all special committees, unless otherwise ordered by the Board.

In case of the absence, or disability of the President, the Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President. If both the President and the Vice-President are absent, the Clerk shall serve as President. If all three officers are absent, the remaining members, if a quorum, shall select one member to serve as President Pro Tem.

The President of the Board of Trustees shall have all the rights of any member of the Board, including the right to move, second, discuss, and vote on any and all questions before the Board.
