GRADING

TITLE 5: 55760, 55750-2, 55758

It shall be the policy of the Sonoma County Junior College District to develop and implement regulations governing grading practices and units awarded which are consistent with the Administrative Code, Title 5. These regulations shall be stated in detail in the College Catalog.

Instructors are expected to maintain a complete and accurate record of student achievement.

All test scores, including final examinations, and course grades may be posted at the discretion of instructors. Instructors will utilize every precaution to preclude violation of student confidentiality. The use of the official student identification number is appropriate; anonymity is mandatory.

Notices may be issued at midterm time to students enrolled in semester length courses when unsatisfactory progress has been recorded.

If all financial and other obligations have been cleared, final grades are made available to all students at the close of the semester.

In accordance with Section 55760 of the California Code of Regulations, Title 5, the determination of the student's grade by the instructor shall be final in the absence of mistake, fraud, bad faith, or incompetency. Student requests for grade changes must be initiated no later than two years from the date the grade was posted.
