CAMPUS LABORATORY SCHOOL IN RELATION TO NON-CUSTODIAL PARENT VISITING AND
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDERS

The Santa Rosa Junior College Children's Center assumes no responsibility for enforcing visiting arrangements between parents who are separated or divorced and will not serve as a visitation site for non-custodial parents. Any parent listed in the college's information as being authorized to pick up their child may do so at his or her discretion. The District will not accept responsibility for enforcing the days and times of those pickups. The District will not release a child to a parent who is not on the college's authorized list of people who may pick up the child.

The District will make reasonable efforts to respect all effective temporary restraining orders or emergency protective orders until that document is no longer in effect. A verbal or written request by the parent that they no longer wish for the restraining order to be in effect is not sufficient. The District will assume that the directives in the restraining order are valid until there is a court order stating it is no longer in effect. Parents are required to file the restraining order with the SRJC District Police.
