In recognition of the College's community service mission, the Board establishes a Community Education Program. The program consists of courses and events designed to enhance the cultural, educational and recreational needs and to further the professional goals of individuals in the community. These educational and cultural activities are not associated with academic credit. Examples of such programs are a wide range of not-for-credit, fee-supported courses including a Traffic Violator School and a summer College for Kids Program. Courses are wholly self-supporting. Community Education offers an Arts and Lectures and a Chamber Concert series, and shows for the community and for school groups in the College's Planetarium.
