PUBLIC REVIEW AND ADOPTION OF FINAL BUDGET

The Board shall hold a public hearing on the proposed budget for the ensuing fiscal year in a District facility or some other place conveniently accessible to the residents of the District. The hearing shall be any day during or before the fifteenth of September but at least three days following availability of the proposed budget for public inspection.

The budget hearing will be concluded on the proposed budget when there are no requests for further hearing on file, and the final adoption of the budget shall not take place until the hearing is concluded. The budget shall not be finally adopted by the Board until after the public hearing has been held.

The proposed budget, containing such fiscal information as may be required by the Chancellor, shall be made available by the District for public inspection in a facility of the District three days before the second Tuesday in September.

Locations, dates and times where the proposed budget may be inspected, and the time, date and place where the public hearing on the budget will be held will be published by the County Superintendent of Schools in a newspaper of general circulation in the District, or, if there is no such newspaper, then in a newspaper of general distribution in the county at least three days prior to the availability of the proposed budget for public inspection.

On or before the 15th day of September, the Board shall adopt a final budget.

On or before the 30th day of September, the District shall submit two copies of its adopted annual financial and budget report to the Chancellor. The District shall also file copies of the report with the appropriate county officers for information and review.
