LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

ADOPT: APRIL 8, 1985

REVISED: DECEMBER 12, 2000

REVIEWED: MARCH 11, 2008

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The Board of Trustees shall reserve the right to fix liquidated damages and/or direct expenses against a contractor who fails to complete the construction contract work within the time established for completion, together with extensions granted by the District for unavoidable delays. The contractor shall become liable to the District in the amount specified in the contract per calendar day for each day said contract remains uncompleted beyond the time for completion and/or for any direct documented additional District expenses incurred due to the contractor's delay, as and for liquidated damages or direct expenses and not as a penalty.
