BIDDING AND DOCUMENTATION

Upon approval of final drawings and specifications, the Board of Trustees may authorize the public bidding of the project. Bid documents, including specifications and contracts, bonds, etc., shall be prepared and assembled by the District's consultant (architect or engineer). Bid documents will be reviewed and approved as to content and form by the District and its legal counsel.

The District will follow the mandated public bidding process including the publishing of bid dates in local periodicals and trade journals. Award of the bid will be to the lowest responsive and qualified bidder.
