DISTRICT SMOKE-FREE CAMPUS ENVIRONMENT POLICY

It is the policy of the Sonoma County Junior College District Board of Trustees to promote a safe and healthful atmosphere for students, faculty, staff and visitors on its campuses, centers and other off-campus sites by reducing the health risks associated with tobacco smoke and related products and minimizing discomfort and inconvenience to all concerned. To meet that obligation, the District has a smoke-free campus environment policy.

As of July 1, 2005, smoking and all other uses of tobacco are prohibited on all property and in all indoor and outdoor spaces owned, leased, licensed, or otherwise controlled by the District.
