The Board establishes the Santa Rosa Junior College Foundation, a tax-exempt, non-profit organization, incorporated under the laws of the state of California. The Board of Directors of the Foundation shall be composed of a minimum of 20 members from the public at large, the Superintendent/President who shall serve as the Secretary and the Vice President of Business Services who shall serve as Treasurer of the Board.

The primary purpose of the organization is to promote the welfare of the students and educational programs of Santa Rosa Junior College. To this end, the Foundation solicits gifts and contributions which the Board will reserve as endowment capital, or use in accordance with instructions of donors.
