SPECIAL ADMISSION OF K-12 STUDENTS

Santa Rosa Junior College may permit the admission of K-12 students who, in the opinion of the Superintendent/President, or designee, can benefit from the College's advanced scholastic or vocational curricula.

The intent of this policy is to provide concurrent educational opportunity for a limited number of eligible students who fulfill special admission standards.

Special admission students shall obtain the consent of their parents, secure official authorization from the principal of the school which they attend and comply with all other specific supplemental application materials, assessment requirements, health clearance and any other criteria for admission determined necessary by the College.

The College reserves the right to exclude or limit enrollment into impacted programs and in other programs where health, safety, instructional methodology, facility constraints or legal requirements are deemed inappropriate for special admission students.

Pursuant to Senate Bill 338 (SB338), the College will limit enrollment in College classes by high school students to not more than 5% per grade level, per school during the Summer semester. Additionally, the enrollment of high school students in all Physical Education courses will be limited to 10% per course section during every semester.

Special admission students shall conform to the College's rules and regulations and the code of conduct expected of all college students.

Appeals to decisions regarding special admission will be considered by the Director of Admissions & Enrollment or College administration designee.
