It is the policy of the District to classify non-resident police academy and in-service law enforcement students as a resident for purposes of enrollment in and completion of police academy training courses. Each eligible student must meet the college's police academy entrance requirements and provide written assurance from a public agency that they will be employed as a peace officer in California upon successful completion of the police academy training course.

Administrative procedures are available in the campus Admissions Offices and at the Public Safety Training Center.
