ADMISSION AND ENROLLMENT

The Sonoma County Junior College District shall admit any California resident possessing a high school diploma or the equivalent or any other California resident who is at least 18 years of age who is capable of profiting from the instruction offered. Admission of special groups of students (high school students, apprentice students, students in special programs, non-residents) is contingent upon certain additional criteria specified in the College Catalog. Readmission of students is granted subject to standards of performance in work previously completed at the Junior College.

Students who do not remain in continuous enrollment are subject to all academic policies and requirements as stated in the College Catalog in effect at the time of their resumption of enrollment.

It shall be the policy of the Board to establish special requirements and admission procedures for impacted programs and in other programs where health, safety, legal requirements of the facility are limiting factors in the conduct of a course. Prerequisites, requirements and fair and equitable procedures to meet such limitations shall be established.

International students shall be admitted in approved study programs in accordance with regulations established by the Immigration and Naturalization Service. The District will maintain specific admission criteria, requirements and procedures that govern the selection of international student applicants for admission.
