STUDENT GOVERNMENT

The Sonoma County Junior College District has authorized the organization of the Associated Students of Santa Rosa Junior College as the student governing body. A constitution, subject to approval and adoption by the constituents, and approval by the Board of Trustees sets forth the duties and responsibilities of the organization and its officers.

An appropriate employee of the College shall be designated as advisor to all Associated Students governing bodies and committees. In order for these groups to conduct business, the advisor or designee must be present. This includes all meetings subject to the Ralph M. Brown Act.

The funds of the Associated Students are derived from the Student Representation Fee, student membership fees, and activities sponsored by the Associated Students organizations. The appropriate governing body of the Associated Students formulates, adopts, and expends the annual budget with the advice and assistance of its advisor in accordance with the financial code of the Associated Students and the State of California Education Code. Business Services reviews the overall financial control of these funds.

It is the policy of the College to financially assist, when possible, the activities and programs sponsored by the Associated Students.
