It shall be the policy of the Sonoma County Junior College District to provide Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) to eligible economically and educationally disadvantaged students in order to assist them to achieve their academic goals at Santa Rosa Junior College. Support services may include but not be limited to outreach, recruitment, counseling, early registration, books, grants, child care priority, transfer fee waivers, and other related services.

Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) will include guidelines, procedures, and standards in compliance with the regulatory requirements as set forth in the Education Code Article 8 (commencing with Section 69640) and Title 5 Chapter 2.5 Division 8 of Part VI of the California Administrative Code (commencing with Section 56200).
