

Final Things to Check in Your Web Site

1. Nav bar – make it exactly the same on each page of your site (with the possible exception of your image pages linked to from the thumbnails page), and de-link the name of the page you are currently on.
2. Be sure that your external style sheet is linked to each page of your site.
3. Verify that all links work and all images appear as expected.
4. Be sure that every page has both XHTML and CSS validator buttons on it. Validate each page to be sure no errors have been introduced since it was last checked.
5. Adjust any pages that look “out of place” in your site. You want the same look and feel throughout.
6. Check to be sure that you haven’t use any empty tags improperly, such as `
</br>` or `<hr></hr>`. The validator doesn’t catch these errors, but I might!
