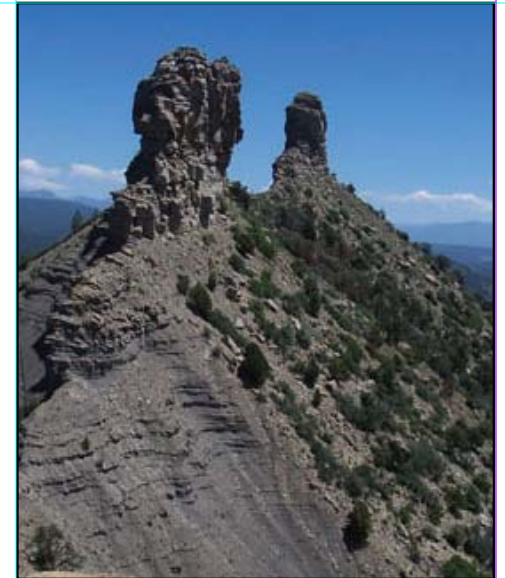
Area Attractions



The Town of Pagosa Springs is a scenic community known for its healing waters, natural hot springs with a remarkably high mineral content. "Pagosah" is a Southern Ute word for "healing waters". Today, visitors enjoy these springs at established spas near the banks of the San Juan River.



A 47 mile breathtaking drive into the San Juan Mountains, Silverton is the starting point for explorations into old mining camps at even higher altitudes. It's also the turnaround point for the Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad, which makes daily stops in this town known for its original Western character with wide streets, old hotels, and museums. The entire town of Silverton is a National Historic District.



Visitors to Chimney Rock Archaeological Area learn firsthand about the culture and lifestyle of the early people of Chimney Rock. One thousand years ago, these Ancient Pueblans, formerly called the Anasazi, built over 200 homes and ceremonial buildings near the sacred twin rock pinnacles.
