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## Pagosa Springs Flier

*This week focuses on setting up a document with ruler guides and a master page. A good InDesign document has its elements lined up and organized.*

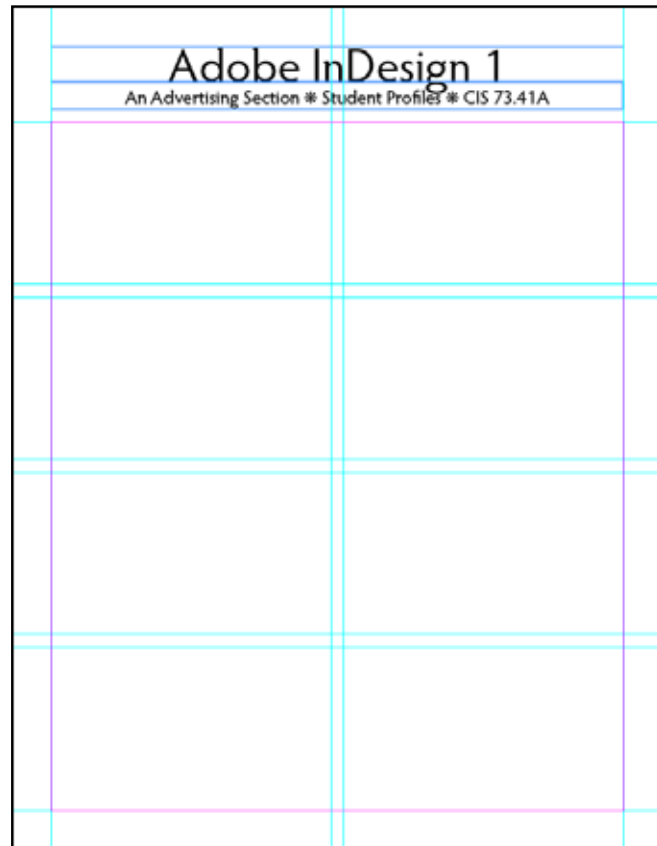

## Part 4: Building community

Check out the student profile catalog and poll info at the Class website (posted later in the week). This is where you can meet your fellow classmates.

Here are the steps I used to create this class catalog:

1. The **Layout..Create Guides** menu was used to impose a 4 row x 2 column set of ruler guides on the master page as shown to the right.
2. Header/footer text frames were created on the master page.
3. Using the **File..Place** menu, all of the submitted student profiles from Lab 2 were selected and imported into the catalog. InDesign treats the PDFs just like a graphic. When multiple files are selected, each click releases one file out of the series into the document.
4. The student profile catalog was saved and exported as a PDF for posting on the class website. In Acrobat, I activated any hyperlinks from student profiles.
